

Levens CE Primary School Sport Provision Statement for the Academic Year 2014-2015

In 2014-15 (academic year), we received £8270 and we are using this to improve our provision through:

- Developing a partnership with Queen Elizabeth School, Kirkby Lonsdale to receive age specific specialist programmes, delivered at the secondary school by specialist teachers. This includes Y4/5/6 hockey. Y3/4 gymnastics, YR/1 athletics (£1250 pa).
- Providing training, (including supply cover to facilitate this) for development of PE teaching skills (£500)
- Providing new sports equipment (£1600)
- Providing a range of sports/PE opportunities in school, led by sports professionals/coaches in curriculum time: KS1 Street Dance, Y4/5/6 Multi Skills, whole school tennis (£1170).
- Funding transport to/from venues for schools sports events, fell walks, sports sessions at Queen Elizabeth School (£1625)
- Providing an Outdoor Education programme delivered by Dallam Outdoors. This will include a caving day for YR/1, a canoe rafting day for Y3/4 and a ghyll scrambling day for Y4/5/6. In addition, Dallam Outdoors are leading 3 separate fell walks for YR/1, Y2/3 and Y4/5/6/ respectively (£2310)

Impact (and future aims)

The impact of provision 2014-15 has been good and has helped us to meet of our aims (listed above). Evidence includes:

- Pupils are enthusiastic. A pupil survey agreed that there is an excellent range and diversity of activities to enjoy.
- Parents are enthusiastic. Parents respond that extended competition, visits to other schools and opportunities to participate in the outdoor education activities have been exceptional.
- High levels of pupil participation in extra-curricular sports activities: 60% of KS2 pupils participate in running club and football club.
- PE subject leader has attended training and PE co-ordinator meetings, increasing his skills and knowledge
- As parent and pupil feedback includes requests for more extra-curricular/inter-school PE/sports opportunities, especially for KS1 pupils, this will be a continued aim for next year
