PE / Physical Development

Mrs Winstanley will be continuing to develop our ball skills and coordination, using our feet and hands.

Phonics

<u>Phase 4 (Yr 1)</u> - each lesson will ensure that they can recognise and recall graphemes to support reading and spelling. The children will be practicing to blend and segment CVCC and CCVC words.

<u>Phase 5 (Y1)</u>

The children will broaden their knowledge of graphemes and phonemes for use in reading and spelling. They will learn new graphemes and alternative pronunciations for these and graphemes they already know.
