Report for the December Board of Governors' Meeting

The Levens School Board of Governors met on 10th December 2020. The key points of the meeting are as follows:

- Simon Webb's term of office as Parent Governor ended on 10 December and he was thanked for his valuable contributions during this time. Nominations have been sought from the parent body for this role.
- Governors accepted the Budget Control Report and the audited School Funds 19/20.
- The current version of the School Development Plan was presented to the Board. •
- The Head Teacher updated Governors on the way they are continuing to manage the school day to ensure pupils', their families and teachers' safety, by following all government guidance relating to Covid 19. Governors were pleased that there had been no incidence of 'bubbles'/children having to be sent home and that this was in part due to the diligence of everyone involved. Governors noted that attendance currently is 98.21% which is well above local and national statistics.
- Governors again expressed thanks to the Head Teacher and all the staff for their continuing commitment and hard work to deal with the current challenging situation.
- The Head Teacher was delighted to report that a Grant had been given to the school by • a local family and this would enable all Y2 children to have violin lessons.
- An update was received on the Sport Provision Strategy with details of how Sports and PE funding is spent.
- The new NGA Governor Code of Conduct and DfE Governor Role updates was covered as a reminder of the board's roles and responsibilities.
- Governors were also updated on training available and encouraged to participate in online sessions next term.
- Various policies were reviewed and approved.
