The full Board of Governors met on Thursday 6th July 2017.

An update was given on the vacant Parent Governor position. Mrs Coker confirmed that no parent nominations had been received for the position. The deadline was 22 June 2017.

The election of a new Chair and Vice Chair of Governors will take place at the Board Meeting in September 2017.

Levens budget 17/18 was submitted to the LA by the deadline of 31 May 2017. To date, there has been no acknowledgement received.

An 'Extremism and Radicalisation' Risk Assessment was submitted to the Board, for discussion. Governors felt that areas of the document need further consideration and this is in the process of being addressed.

Both Mrs Farraday and Mrs Wadey have now been trained to Level 3 in Safeguarding.

The Governors were asked to review the School Development Plan 2016/17, with a view to agreeing the next steps for 2017/18.

Regarding the new School Structure and Staffing for September 2017, Mrs Farraday is very much looking forward to spending more of her time concentrating on the day to day running of the school, now that she no longer has to devote a significant amount of her time to teaching. Miss Dawson will be joining Levens School in September 2017 to teach Scafell Class.
