On behalf of the staff team at Levens School, I would like to say a very big thank you to all our families for your generosity this Christmas. We are all absolutely overwhelmed by your kindness in treating us to gifts and a festive meal at the Hare and Hounds this week. You are all so very, very kind and we appreciate it massively. Thank you!

Thank you also for your support of FOLS Christmas events over the last few weeks, including our Christmas Fair at the start of December. We have raised over £1500 this month alone which will go towards a mobile cooking station for our food technology curriculum and provide a subsidy to parents for our summer term outdoor adventure trips! A small percentage of our funds will also go to our Blessed Hill Appeal. The next event in the diary is the school disco, taking place early in the spring term.

Christmas Fundraising for Blessed Hill School and Orphanage:
