Who will help us learn?

Miss Heaton will teach Class 2 with the support of Mrs Court in the mornings, and Mrs Mason in the afternoons. On a Monday afternoon the children will have PE with Mrs Craggs.

What do I need to bring to school?



Your child should have a *named* water bottle in school. **PE kits** should be in school at <u>all</u> <u>times</u> so that children are able to participate in PE. **Reading books** should be brought into school **every day** including their reading record. Books will be changed on a Monday and Friday if there is a comment from reading the book. It is the children's responsibility to hand their reading books into the correct year group box every morning. Our PE days are **Monday** and **Wednesday** and Barrow Raiders on a **Friday**.

Homework

Homework will be given in the phonic/spelling book. This needs to be handed in at school on a **Thursday** each week. The children will then get homework relating to their phonics/spelling work. Within these books there is also the year 1 and 2 common exception words which a lot of them do not follow a spelling pattern and need to be learnt please also take some time to practice these. Reading little and often is also part of homework in class 2.



Spring Term Curriculum 2024:


Maths: To start the spring term off the children will be developing their understanding of 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. We will then move on to learning about money. Following on from this we will then deepen our understanding of length and height, finishing the term off with learning the concept of multiplication and division. We will also continue to deepen our knowledge of place value and how we can read and write numbers to 100 using the correct formation.

English: We will begin by reading 'The Three Little Pigs' with a focus on traditional tales. This will lead us into lots of reading, acting, story mapping and creating our own versions of the story.



During the second half of the term we will be focusing our English work on the video extract 'The Tale of Peter Rabbit'. This will lead us into looking at the different stories of Peter Rabbit and how we can build up our vocabulary into creating our own story setting using descriptive writing. We will continue to enhance our vocabulary skills during our English lessons.

Reading will play a <u>big</u> part in getting to know and understand our whole class texts and we will also read independently as well as during Guided Reading sessions (group reading) during





Science: Our Science topic this term is materials. We will be learning about a variety of different materials, their properties and their uses! This will include using different experiments to gain a deeper understanding!

Topic: (History and Geography) During the first part of the spring term we will be focusing on Geography locating and identifying characteristics of four countries and the capital cities of the UK including its surrounding seas. In the second half of the spring term we will have a History focus which links with our English work of Beatrix Potter.

PE: Mrs Craggs will continue to teach the children PE on a Monday afternoon which will be the fundamental skills. Miss Heaton continues to teach PE on a Wednesday afternoon which we will start with dance!

Computing: This term we will be learning about moving robots and how algorithms work and debugging simple programs.

RE: Our whole school Christian Value is 'Thankfulness' this term. There will also be learning linked to Baptism and Easter.

DT: We will be exploring different structures in the first part of spring then we will be learning about different textiles in spring 2.

Art: As well as expressing ourselves and exploring different media in our creative area, we will also be using clay to create an animal sculpture inspired from the artist Nick Blackman. We will also continue to look at buildings in our local area and create some architectural prints of them.

Music: This term we will have a focus on rhythm and pitch looking at different tempos and dynamics.

SCARF: During our PSHE sessions this term we will be focusing on special people around us and discovering why our bodies are important to us!
