Attendance and reporting absence:

Before we finish for the Christmas break, may I remind parents of our procedures for reporting absence. Please either email or call the office on the first day of your child's absence to report the absence and the reason. We request that parents/carers follow this up with further updates on each subsequent day of absence so that we are fulfilling our statutory responsibilities and implementing any pastoral support if required.

Holidays are not considered to be exceptional circumstances and in all cases these are referred to the W+F Council attendance officer to determine further action. Information about how to request leave of absence in term time can be found on the attendance page of our website.

So far this term, we have an incredible 31 pupils who have attended school every day since the start of September. These children will be provided with a certificate and a small prize at the start of the spring term.

Emergency Closure of School:

In the unlikely event that we would need to close the school, we would inform you via email and text as promptly as possible. This might be due to a problem with our heating

or electricity supply, but could also be due to extreme weather. Staff at Levens travel in from various remote areas within and beyond Cumbria, therefore regardless of the conditions in Levens, staff may be unable to get into work due to treacherous road conditions. If sufficient staffing levels in school cannot be guaranteed, a decision to close may be unavoidable.

In these circumstances, class teachers would be in touch via email to offer suggestions of work that can be completed at home. Further information about our remote learning offer can be found on our website.
